My husband and I had one cat and two dogs, Maddy and Max. As Max was now 15 and aging rapidly, our six-year-old dog, Maddy, was losing her playmate and was trying unsuccess-

fully to play with our older cat, Myah. We introduced Sabrina, a six-month-old black kitten we got through Friends of Beverly Animals. When I first met Sabrina, she was more shy than her sibling but made better eye contact and seemed more intelligent. After sleeping with her in a separate room for three nights, she was quickly out in the main part of the house by day five — eating out of Max's bowl with him (and he is an imposing 85 pound lab, pit bull mix), walking between both dogs' legs, and showing no fear of any of our pets. Our dogs adored her, especially Maddy, who snuffles her and only growls when she tries to get into her feed bowl or if Sabrina tries to lick Maddy's ear. Myah is a bit less enthusiastic, but the product Comfort Zone (a spray or diffuser that actually works) has helped because if I take the diffuser out, the growls start back up from my older cat.

Sabrina is very playful...she has scattered about 150 pretzel sticks over the floor one night, has knocked the top of the beta fish tank (uh-oh), and is a typical, adorable six-monthold kitten who loves to sleep in drawers or on top of my belly, after just a few short weeks. She can "misplace" twelve plastic balls with bells within a few days, sending us to our hands and knees to search and rescue the missing ones. So the shy, skittish ones are not always the shy, skittish ones with some TLC and patience. Timing was perfect for our family, too, because just after Sabrina's adjustment period, we had to euthanize our aging 15 year old Max, with a very sad heart, but Sabrina's playfulness and her bond with our other dog made the adjustment less difficult. We are looking forward to a long, healthy life for her and can't thank FOBA enough for helping us add this bundle of joy to our brood.
