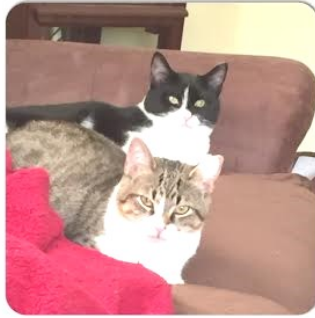
Don't act so eager. Stare at your food. It drives them crazy.

We **LOVE** her. Here is our story...

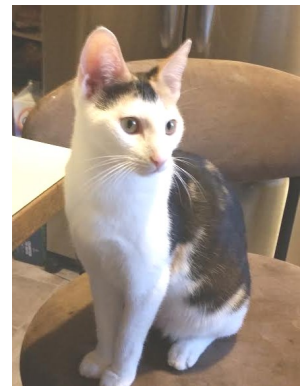

We love to play with her with shoelaces. She never seems to get bored with it. She also loves to chase a laser light.

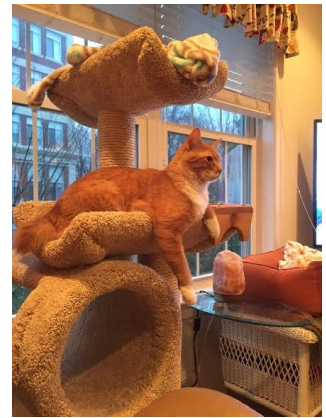
Calie is very cuddly, she will jump on our lap and nap. She never runs away to hide, she is very social.
